Affordable Care Act - Exchange Insurance January 1, 2017

Eligible Employees and Dependents who are not currently enrolled in an Egyptian Trust Medical Planmay enroll as follows.

If you are enrolled in a medical plan through the insurance exchange, you will be permitted to drop that coverage and enroll in one of the Egyptian Trust health plans offered by your employer. Your effective date will be January 1, 2017.

Your employer must have your signed enrollment form in their possession by December 31, 2016 in order to have coverage effective January 1, 2017.

Covered employees may add any eligible dependent(s) not currently enrolled in one of the Egyptian Trust health plans for the reason that the eligible dependent was enrolled in a plan through the insurance exchange, (all family members must be covered under the same medical plan).

Retired former employees may not add dependents during this period.

IMPORTANT: Please complete all fields on the enrollment form including your date of birth, employee and dependent Social Security numbers, email address and phone number where you can be reached in the event the Care Coordinators need to contact you.

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Employees and dependents who are currently enrolled in an Egyptian Trust medical plan and wish to enroll for insurance through the Exchange *may terminate coverage* under the Egyptian Trust medical plan as follows:

- You may terminate the Egyptian Trust medical plan ONLY if you provide documentation to your employer that you have enrolled and secured insurance through the insurance exchange.
- Your termination of the Egyptian Trust medical plan will coincide with the effective date of the enrollment in the insurance exchange (January 1, 2017).

Other changes are not permitted, specifically:

- You may not change plans during this period.
- You may not drop Trust coverage without enrolling for coverage through the exchange.
- You may not make any changes to the voluntary vision, dental, and life programs until the next annual open enrollment period.

Any changes you make during this period will be irrevocable until the Egyptian Trust's next annual open enrollment unless you experience a qualifying change in status or Special Enrollment Event.

Coverage changes for 3-D Mammograms

Effective July 1, 2016, preventive 3-D mammograms are covered by the Egyptian Trust medical plans at 100 percent when using a network provider.

Egyptian Trust Website Updates

The Egyptian Trust website is updated each time any of the Trust information changes or updated information is available. Keep in mind this site houses all the information about all of the programs offered by the Trust – not just the health plans. In order to be sure you are viewing the most recent version of the website you should periodically clear your "cookies". You may do so by going to your Internet Options to clear "cookies". Once your "cookies" have been cleared "refresh" your screen. You can do this by pressing F5 on your keyboard. You can confirm that this has worked by checking the meetings dates listed on the Home Page. The only dates that should appear are March 22, 2017 and May 10, 2017.



Your DocFind® Online Directory Coventry (CMR) and Aetna Choice® Point of Service (POS) II

Beginning January 1, 2017 members will have access to both Coventry (CMR) and Aetna Choice Point of Service (POS) II. Until then, members have access to Coventry (CMR) when seeking services in Illinois or Missouri and access to Aetna Choice POS II outside of Illinois or Missouri.

Due to the integration of Coventry and Aetna networks you and your family will now be able to access Coventry or Aetna Choice POS II providers. You can look for doctors and hospitals in the Coventry network or the Aetna Choice POS II network using the online DocFind directory. With up-to-date listings, you can search for providers by name, specialty, gender, hospital affiliations and more.

Find network providers online in just a few quick steps

You can use the DocFind directory anywhere you have internet access. Just:


- Visit <u>eqtrust.org</u> > Medical Benefits> Finding a Network Provider> 2017 CMR/Aetna Choice POS II Link.
- Key in the type of provider or provider name, specialty, procedure or condition under *Enter name*, specialty, procedure or condition and the desired geographical location by entering the zip code or city and state under *Zip Code or City*, *State*. Click *Search*.
- The Select a Plan drop-down box allows you to choose your provider network. Select either the CMR or Aetna Choice POS II (Open Access) network. (See below) If you do not find the particular provider you are looking for under one network remember to check the other network as now you have access to both networks regardless of the geography.

OR

- Search using the list of *Common Searches* by clicking on one of the options listed under *Provider Types, Conditions or Procedures.* You will be prompted to key in the desired geographical area and select your plan (See below). Choose your provider from the list of providers displayed on the results screen. You can learn more about each by clicking on the provider's name.
- Narrow your search results by using the filters under Narrow Your Results. Choices include Language, Gender, Hospital Affiliation, Accepting New Patients, Plan Information, Individual Practice Association (group affiliation) and Type of doctor or facility (specialty).

New ID Cards are on the way

Beginning January 1, 2017 providers will need to file claims to a new claims address. Your new ID Cards have been printed and are being mailed directly to all members homes. When you receive them please destroy previous versions of the health ID Card and begin using the new card for services on or after January 1, 2017. It is important you show your new card so providers may properly file claims to the new address. Incorrect claims filing may cause a delay in the processing of your claims.

If you do not receive a new ID Card it could be that Meritain Health or Quantum Health do not have an updated address on file. Please be sure to update your address with your Human Resources Department/Bookkeeper and call the Care Coordinators to request an ID Card.
