RE: September 28, 2011 Board of Managers Meeting

The next meeting of the Board of Managers of the Egyptian Trust will be held on Wednesday September 28, 2011 beginning at 10:00 a.m. at Governor's Run Golf Course, Carlyle, IL. The agenda is enclosed. All school districts, cooperatives and ROE's are urged to send a representative from their district.

Plans have been made and implemented for the electronic payment of premiums. An agenda item for this meeting proposes a revised penalty for late submission of premiums. The current policy calls for a 10% late premium penalty if the premium is not paid by the 5th of the month for that month's premium. The revised language proposes that premiums paid between one (1) and seven (7) days late would incur a one percent (1%) penalty; premiums paid between eight (8) and fourteen (14) days late would incur a two percent (2%) penalty, and premiums paid more than fifteen (15) days late would incur a five percent (5%) penalty. If approved by the Board of Managers, these penalties would take effect for November, 2011 premiums, which are due by the fifth (5th) of November, 2011.

A second agenda item would limit the time for making enrollment adjustments to 60 days from the date of the event which causes the adjustment. The Benefits Committee will meet on Wednesday, September 14th, with one of the agenda items to be to review the Trust's partial withdrawal policy. A recommendation from the Benefits Committee on that policy may come forward. Further, an informational item will be discussed requiring districts to bi-annually review their covered member roster and certify their actively at work, leave, medical leave, unpaid leave, or retirement status. Meritain will send the roster and the district will make any changes and sign off certifying the correctness of the employee's status.

Finally, it has been suggested that the January Board of Managers meeting be eliminated in favor of holding the December meeting as a Managers meeting. The January meeting usually falls only 4 to 5 weeks after the December meeting. Of course, a special meeting of the Executive or Board of Managers could always be called.
