**RE:** September 25, 2013 Board of Managers Meeting

The next meeting of Board of Managers of the Egyptian Trust will be held on Wednesday, September 25, 2013 beginning at 10:00 a.m. at Governor's Run Golf Course, Carlyle, IL.

The agenda is enclosed. All school districts, cooperatives and ROE's are urged to send a representative to the September 25<sup>th</sup> meeting.

In addition to the reports from all of the Trust's service providers and consultants, a review of the Trust's optional deductible reimbursement programs, Plan E – Options I – IV (formerly known as the Copper Plans), will be undertaken. In recent years, several school districts which paid all or a very large portion of Plan A (formerly the Platinum Plan), negotiated the purchase of the lower priced Plan B (formerly Gold Plan) with the district reimbursing employees and covered dependents for the additional deductible expense when an individual exceeded the Plan A annual deductible.

Now, as finances have gotten tighter, there has been increased interest in Plan E (formerly known as the Copper Plans I, II, III, IV), which were adopted by the Trust in 2009. The 4 Plan E options were based off of Plan B (Gold) but had higher deductibles in \$500 incremental amounts, up to a maximum of \$2,000 over the normal Plan B individual deductibles. At this time, no district has taken the step to go to any of the Plan E options with a significantly higher deductible difference, but there is increasing interest. Plan E – Options I – IV offer premium savings to the district and employees while employees can be made whole by the district for some or all of the additional deductible expense. Meritain will provide the district with the deductible reports on a quarterly, semi-annual, and annual basis or districts may contract with Meritain to make the reimbursements. Please see the attachments for the summary sheet of the 4 Plan E Options, as well as proposed operational procedures for the administration of the deductible reimbursement programs.

A brief review of the current ACA requirements, as well as those which have been postponed, will also be undertaken.

The contract with Coordinated Health Care will also be recommended for approval for another year.
