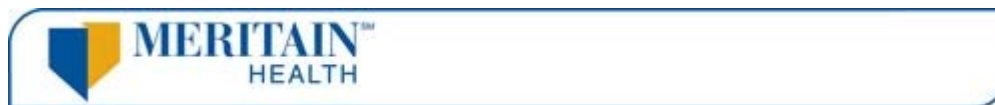

Attached is the following information

- Individual Health Plan Selection Rules
- Individual Health Plan Election Form – We request you complete this form each year to identify the health plan or plans your employees are allowed to enroll in and the effective date of your employee changes will become effective during the open enrollment period. (Either 9/1 or 10/1). This form is due no later than August 1 each year.
- Summary of Plan comparisons (Platinum, Gold, Silver, Bronze) – The major differences between the plans is the deductible and out of pocket levels, and the prescription drug copays. Coverage of services between the plans does not change. Keep in mind the Bronze Plan is an HSA-Qualified High Deductible Health Plan (HDHP).

If you previously completed and sent the form for 2011 and wish to change the health plans you have decided to offer to your eligible employees this year you may simply update the form and return it indicating it is a replacement form.
