Dear Participating Employer Group:

The Egyptian Trust continues to opt out of full compliance with the federal Mental Health Parity law. As a nonfederal governmental plan, the Trust has the right to opt out of compliance with this law. Until final regulations are issued, the Board has chosen to wait to make a decision on whether and how to change the mental health and substance abuse benefits provided under the Plans. To opt out, you are required to provide the attached notice to participants before September 1, 2014 explaining the decision to opt out of the parity requirements.

Also, we recently sent you FAQ's concerning the distribution of the Summary of Benefits and Coverage (SBC) that is required to be distributed. You may recall that last year we provided you with postcards you distributed to your members to advise them of where they can find the SBC's (www.egtrust.org). We have attached a copy of that postcard that you may feel free to print and send to your membership.
