Do you have a dependent over age 19 more than 50% dependent on you for support and enrolled in one of the Egyptian Trust Health Plans? If so, please read on....

If you have not already done so, now is the time to complete the Dependent Status form and fax to Meritain Health in order to assure continued coverage for your over age 19 dependent who is more than 50% dependent on you for support. Note: this does NOT include those over age 19 dependents who are currently enrolled as Full Time Students.

You may find the form at <u>www.egtrust.org</u> by clicking on "Administrative Forms" and then "Dependent Status Form" or click on the following link: <u>http://www.egtrust.org/Dependent%20Status%20Form_7-09.pdf</u> Please fax the completed form to Meritain Health at 888-525-2799 in order to avoid claim processing or prescription filling delays.

Remember, <u>YOU</u> must tell your Employer when your dependent is no longer a qualified eligible dependent and is to be terminated from the health, dental, or vision plan. NOT returning the over age 19 Dependent form does NOT terminate the dependent's coverage – it only suspends the coverage until we receive either a) the updated form or b) a termination notice from your Employer. When coverage is suspended the appropriate premium continues to be billed to the Employer group. PLEASE be sure to communicate any of your family status changes to your Employer who will be able to provide you with information about how family status changes may affect your benefits. If you're unsure of whether your Employer needs to be notified of a particular change, it is certainly better to touch base with your Bookkeeper or Human Resources Dept. rather than take a chance on missing out on critical information.

A Message from the Trust Retirement, Medicare and the Egyptian Trust Health Insurance

In the coming weeks Meritain Health will be sending a communication directly to those members who are identified in our enrollment system as a Retired Employee. In addition, Meritain Health will send the communication directly to the Superintendent to be distributed to all employees who may be affected (those who may be retiring this year). The communication will address your health insurance options if you are in one of the following categories:

- Retired Non-Certified Staff (Aides, Cooks, Custodians, Bus Drivers, Secretaries, etc) drawing an IMRF Pension with Egyptian Trust Health Insurance
- Active Non Certified Staff Retiring 2011
- Retired Certified Teachers and Administrators drawing a TRS Pension with Egyptian Trust Health Insurance
- Active Certified Staff Retiring 2011

While all Retired Employees are eligible to remain covered by the Egyptian Trust Health Plan, the intent of the information is to make you aware of all of your options for health insurance coverage.

Those who may decide to change to the TRS plan or Medicare supplement plan may continue to have the voluntary dental and vision insurance plan through the Egyptian Trust if they currently have that coverage. The information that will be provided to you concerning the benefit and premium comparisons is our interpretation and understanding. We strongly recommend that you do your own research by talking with a local insurance agent or using the Medicare web site to make your own comparisons prior to making your decision. Remember - The annual Benefit Choice Period for the TRS health insurance plan is May 1 through May 31, 2011 for those who have already retired. TRS will not notify you of this opportunity to enroll in a TRS health insurance plan. You will need to contact them to request information be sent to you.

Express Scripts

Pharmacy Benefit Program Changes Effective January 1, 2011

As a reminder, the Egyptian Trust Board of Managers met on November 8, 2010 and approved a change in the prescription card program <u>EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2011</u>. In particular, the program was changed to allow 90 day <u>maintenance</u> prescriptions to be filled at retail pharmacies participating in the Express Scripts Maintenance Drug Network (MDN), in addition to continuing to allow these fills through Home Delivery. The co-pays for those <u>maintenance</u> medications filled at a participating Express Scripts MDN pharmacy will be slightly higher than those filled through Home Delivery (see the chart below). The reason for the change was twofold.

- First, employees in Egyptian Trust member school districts and cooperatives expressed concern at being required to fill their maintenance medications through Home Delivery or pay a double co-pay for a 30 day fill.
- Secondly, local pharmacists expressed concerns about the amount of business they were losing while pointing out that
 they support their local schools both financially and with time commitments, and also pointing out that they are a
 resource for the local employee who needs help with their medications and those who have questions. Although
 projected savings for the Trust's pharmacy benefit program will be somewhat less than what was originally designed,
 the membership felt it was important to continue to work with and allow retail pharmacies the opportunity to
 participate within the Express Scripts Maintenance Drug Network (MDN).

The benefit design change that became effective **JANUARY 1, 2011** included:

- 1. All <u>maintenance</u> medications may be filled on a 90 day basis through Home Delivery or the Express Scripts MDN network of pharmacies. Most of the pharmacies in our communities are already a part of the MDN network. Local pharmacies that are not part of the MDN network will have the opportunity to sign a contract with Express Scripts to join the MDN network. Pharmacies who are not currently contracted under the Express Scripts MDN network can contact the Contracting Department at 866-296-9943 to request a MDN network contract. The MDN pharmacies agree to accept lower reimbursements from Express Scripts in order to participate in the Maintenance Drug Network.
- 2. Egyptian Trust members will continue to have the option to fill the first two months of a maintenance medication at any local retail pharmacy for the normal 30 day co-pay. After the first two fills of a maintenance medication each fill afterward will be required to be a 90 day fill at either an MDN pharmacy or through Home Delivery. <u>Please Note:</u> <u>Members will not have the option of buying a 30 day supply of maintenance drugs at any retail pharmacy by paying double the normal 30 day co-pay.</u> Members can continue to buy up to a 30 day supply of any covered medication that is not a maintenance medication and is not a specialty medication at any retail pharmacy.
- 3. The co-pay for a 90 day fill at the MDN pharmacy is higher than the Home Delivery co-pay. Past practice by covered employees has seen the vast majority of generic <u>maintenance</u> prescriptions filled on a 30 day basis, indicating members have been paying three normal 30 day prescription co-pays. The proposed 90 day MDN co-pay for generic drugs is the equivalent of three 30 day retail co-pays and is needed to help offset the higher discounts the Trust receives for mail order versus retail fills.

The 90 day co-pay for brand formulary and non-formulary medications is higher at MDN pharmacies than through Home Delivery for the same reason.

- Q1. What is Bill Me Later?
- A1. Bill Me Later is a new third-party payment option that Express Scripts accepts as a form of payment over the Web and phone. Express Scripts will accept Bill Me Later[®], MasterCard[®], Visa[®], Discover[®] and Amex[®].

Q2. How do members sign up for a Bill Me Later account?

A2. Members can sign up right on the Express Scripts Website or through an Express Scripts Patient Care Advocate. Simply choose Bill Me Later as the payment method at checkout, answer a few quick questions, accept the terms and that's it. Approval only takes a few seconds. Members will then receive a bill in the mail directly from Bill Me Later. There is no sign up prior to making a purchase, and there is no sign-up fee.

Q3. What is Express Scripts special offer with Bill Me Later?

- A3. Orders that are at least \$150 qualify for "No Payments for 6 Months". Members will receive monthly statements for purchases but they will not be required to make a payment until the billing statement following the promotional expiration date.
